With great pleasure let me welcome each and everyone gathered here.

I am delighted to present the Annual Report of our School for the session 2024-2025 which gives a precise review of our schools progress and achievements.

We are an institution of Academic excellence, teaching and leading our students to build strong character, courage, confidence and intellectual competence.

We achieved 100% results in the CBSE Board Examination for the academic year 2023-2024. Vrinda.K stood first with 95.4%. She scored 100 marks for Sanskrit. She was awarded with trophy and certificate by Palakkad Sahodaya on the Merit day. Vrinda and Sanskrit teacher Baby Shalini were acknowledged by our Management on the School Merit day.

This year again we have taken great efforts to mould our class 10 students to face the board examination which begins on February 15th. We have done multiple assessments, periodic tests, weekly assessments, 2 term exams, and 3 model examinations to equip them for the CBSE Board examination. Let God grace our children with blessings. We, the Management, Staff and students wish them good luck for their future endeavors.

Talent Search Examination aims to gain a better grasp of their course work, enhance their academic abilities & sharpen their analytical and problem- solving skills. We bagged the State level first and second positions in the Talent Search examination conducted by BVN. Sarang T S of class 8 bagged the Gold medal and Adwaith Krishna of class 7 bagged the silver medal for the academic year 2023-2024. This year again 10 of our students have attended State level examination last week.

We conduct quiz competition every week from classes I to 10 to make our students more inquisitive about the world around them. This makes our children to be competent to face all the competitive examinations. Winners of each week are crowned as the 'Stars of the week'. The Mega stars are Vedavimal of 1A, Mithreya T S of Class 3, Sreenadh P of class 7, Sarang T.S of Class 8. They have shown excellent performance throughout the academic year.

In the Inter-School quiz competition along with Palakkad Sahodaya School participants our School remained the stars. Suryajith of class 10 and Sarang of class 8 were our team members of high school section and they bagged cash award of rupees 5000. This shows that our regular efforts of moulding mega stars by conducting quiz competitions has reflected in the Inter-school competition.

Apart from preparing children to qualify for purely academic demands special efforts are being made continuously in co-curricular activities also. We all know that creativity involves breaking out established pattern in order to look at things in a different way.

Our School has always taken initiatives to get the best talent in the sports arena. We conducted summer camp for football and kho-kho. We have also executed Scouts and Guides in our campus to build team spirit, confidence and self-esteem among the students. Champions aren't born - they are made in practice, molded by effort and driven by relentless passion and an unwavering belief in oneself.

In the National Pencasilat Championship held at Jammu & Kashmir, Sreya Mohan of class 6 grabbed silver medal in fighting and in solo under 12 category. She picked the bronze medal.

In the Palakkad district Sahodaya Kho-Kho championship our students Anjana, Kavya, Avanthika of class 10, Niranjana and Ann Mary of class 9, Anjali, Alakananada, Ardra of class 8 and Niveditha R, Niveditha K, Vyga Sankar of class 7 showcased outstanding performance and grabbed the Second Runner-up position.

In the BVN State level Athletics, Aney Mohan of class 8 bagged second position in 600 m race and third position in long jump.

The game chess encourages creativity and teaches children to think outside the box, fostering a growth mindset essential for success in academics and beyond. Our little chess master Aiswarya N of class 8 qualified as the first runner-up in Vidya Bharathi South zone Chess Championship which was held in Chennai.

We hosted BVN Palakkad district Science fest. Our school secured the overall top position in the district science fest. In the State level science fest, Athul krishna of class 10 secured second position in maths practicals and in Science paper presentation Sreya of class 9 secured the second position.

We also participated in the Palakkad Sahodaya Kalavotsav and Science fest.

Let us appreciate Kashinath P of class 8 for being honoured by Vallapuzha Grama Panchayath as "kuttikarshagan". He was awarded for Apiculture and for harvesting honey.

In the Prashnamanch district competition, Kishore team bagged the second position .

To develop total personality of the child Vidyabharathi has prescribed a national syllabus considering 5 aspects 'Panchanga Sikshan' ie. Physical, Yoga, Music, Sanskrit, Moral & Spiritual education which we are following in its true spirit.

Our value education programme is not restricted to an allotted period. Every available opportunity from daily Agnihotrum to regular classes is used for developing the values.

Vedagurukulam conducted Valmiki Ramyana quiz competition and Aparna R Nair of class 2 B won first prize & a cash award of rupees 3000.

An indigenous system of pre-primary education based on Bharathiya Samskriti 'Sisuvatika' is flourishing in our school for the past two decades. This year they have completed 80 activities in a spontaneous and natural way.

We have also gone ahead with various club activities. Coding club, Social Science club, Health club, Literary club, Maths club, Science club activities also functioned smoothly.

School magazine is a source of pride for the students and a way for parents to reminisce child's school years. Our students have contributed their creativity and today it is a great pleasure for us to release the school magazine.

Continuous Professional Development has proven to be a critical part of the teaching-learning process. Learn, unlearn & relearn is the only way to be an outstanding and successful teacher. Our teachers have attended inservice training programmes conducted by BVN & CBSE. All the training sessions helped our teachers to empower themselves.

This year we celebrated the second edition School level digital fest where our students showcased their digital skills in the areas like AI, RHOBOTICS, IOT, Websites, Mobile Apps, Animation, Documentary, Film and visual coding, Games, Techtalk etc. Our 6 students participated in the second edition Global Indian Digital fest.

We have also tried to include smart classes as an educational tool for making teaching learning process interesting with the minimum facility available.

We have conducted one general PTA and a parental awareness session in the month of July, Class wise PTA in the month of August, PTA executive meeting in the month of November and an open house meeting towards the mid of November and 3rd class PTA for class 10.

We are happy that we have purchased a brand new Traveller of Force Motors with a seating capacity of 20 + 2 for our students conveyance, A brand new computer as a server for computer lab to perform SAFAL exam (Structured Assessment For Analyzing Learning) conducted by CBSE for Class 3 and 8 students, a brand new Photo Copier cum scanner and a Smart TV .
